

## SPECIAL DIVISIONAL RULES – For 2009 Season Only

Dated 01/07/2009

New Rules for 2009:

- 1) Games may begin and continue with less than five players.
- 2) For B8/12 and G8/12 divisions, teams may full court press even if the team point differential exceeds 12.

This chart describes the special rules applicable within specific divisions of the Boys and Girls Leagues. This is an addendum superseding the Coaches Manual to account for combining divisions.
